No Excuses	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● No excuses will be accepted for any intentional behavior or actions that increase the risk of the spread of Covid19 in the Belmayne ETSS community. <p>The school will follow these steps:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The teacher will speak to the student and ensure they understand the risks of continuing to behave in this manner.2. The teacher will record the incident on VsWare.3. If there is a further incident, the student will be referred to the Deputy Principal who will contact the student's parents to discuss the Health & Safety risks of the student being in school.4. Students who are deemed a Health & Safety risk following consultation with their parents/guardian will not be allowed to attend school.
